Following your email below and our telephone conversation, I confirm that no building alterations are being carried out on either elevation as far as I am aware and our drawing represents a true reflection of what exists from when it was a KFC.

The old KFC entrance portal sign has been removed from in front of the entrance on the west elevation.

As discussed this was a free standing sign arrangement and not part of the building. This is as noted on our drawing.

The existing white fascia on the east elevation is also being removed and I have had this noted on the revised attached drawing for clarity, as agreed.

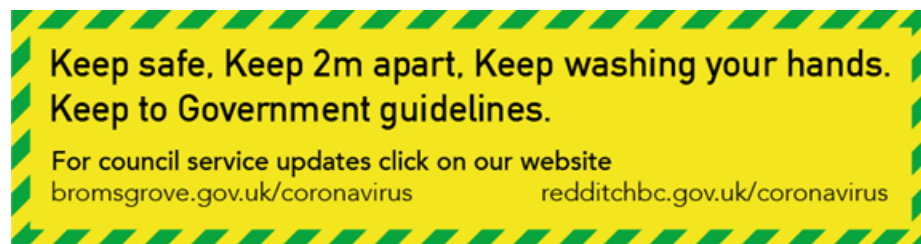
