Condition 20 Dust Suppression

In areas where dust production is likely a hose and brush will be used to suppress dust spread.

The majority of the works associated with the short length of access driveway will be undertaken during the winter and so dust is less likely to occur. However in the event of dry weather, and especially in high wind conditions, dust may still need to be suppressed.

A water supply will be provided on site via an appropriately sized bowser using recycled water.

It is intended to minimize air pollution through dust generation. Measures envisaged include:

- Brushing and water spraying of heavily used site hard surfaces and access points as required:
- Vehicles transporting materials capable of generating dust to and from the site to be suitably sheeted on each journey to prevent the release of materials and particulate matter.
- Effective wheel/body cleaning facilities to be provided and used as necessary.
- Burning of waste or unwanted materials will not be permitted on site.
- Where elements of work are likely to produce dust, only tools with dust suppression and collection kit will be permitted to be used.
- Vehicle movements and dust generating activities are to be kept to a minimum.
