- T2 The remaining length of the branches will be approximately 1-1.5meters where the best nearest growth point allows
- T3 The remaining length of the branches will be approximately 2 meters where the best nearest growth point allows
- T4 The remaining length of the branches will be approximately 2-2.5meters where the best nearest growth point allows
- T7 The remaining length of the branch will be approximately 2meters
- T10 The remaining length of the branches will be approximately 1.5meters where the best nearest growth point allows
- T9 The final crown spread will be 3meters and the final height will be approximately 4-4.5meters where best growth points allow.
