The stud wall infill material where the wall paintings are is: **Riven oak withies and laths for the wattle, with earth and straw daub infill with a haired lime plaster finish applied.**

This to be used as the chosen infill, as fragments of the original 16<sup>th</sup> Century infill material were found in the oak stud wall, when discovered.

Information was provided in the original LBC application method statement to use lime plaster where appropriate and this was approved.
