

Dear sir/madam

I hope you don't mind me contacting you, I just would like to give you some information I forgot to put on my application.

I have found a site that tells how you can estimate the age of a tree, please see the attached file.

Given that the tree at Blake Dr is 200cm in circumference/Dia 64cm it would give its age as about 106 years.

As the house has been there for about 50 years the tree must have grown to approximately twice of its original size of 100 cm/31cm in diameter.

I have calculated that in 50 years the tree has grown to reduced the gap between the tree and the garage by about 16 cm/6.3 inch.

The 16cm reduction in gap between the tree and the garage due to its 50 yr. growth would suggest that it has made a significant reduction in means of access to the property.
